Because The Secretary of State Prohibits Independent Audits **The Nevada Election System Must Be Judged “*Untrustworthy*”**

Banks, Financial Institutions, Government Agencies, Small Businesses & Corporations Are Mandated To Have Independent Audits—Why Not Nevada Secretary of State?

Is it not true that:

- Self-audits are easily corrupted & public reports of their findings are **self-serving**?
- Public Election Ballots are **more valuable than money**, & no one would want to place their money in a bank account that was not independently audited?
- The 3 election elements (**registration, voting & ballot counting**) use unsecure electronic machines, uncleared persons & are known **targets for all types of fraud**?
- Independent Audits Will:
 - * reveal when recounts are needed to verify elections,
 - * deter internal & external fraud,
 - * provide for continuous improvements in elections, &
 - * promote public confidence in election results?

State Elections Are Not Considered Trustworthy Because:

- 1. Voter registrations do not always validate citizenship and legal domiciles**
- 2. Registrants allowed to self-certify they are U.S. Citizens without later validations**
- 3. Voting procedures do not always securely verify voter identities**
- 4. Election system components and procedures do not comply with constantly updated federal security and/or cyber crime standards**
- 5. Legal chain-of-custody records & audit trails are not securely recorded**
- 6. All employees, contractors & volunteers are not background checked**
- 7. Locks on machines appear easily defeated**
- 8. There are no ways to rapidly test & validate the integrity of election system results**
- 9. Independent audits of registrations, voting procedures and system security measures are blocked by Secretary of State & Legislature**

Election Integrity Action Committee Goals:

1. Registrations

- SoS To Enforce Laws: Allow Only U.S. Citizens To Register To Vote
- Require Proof of Citizenship & Legal Domicile to Register
- Link SoS & DHS Data Bases To Cross
- Enable SoS, Counties & Precincts To Verify Data

2. Voting Days

- Manage votes as more valuable than money
- Require valid photo IDs to match registrations before allowing voting
- Change statutes to require Sheriffs & DAs to actively detect, investigate & prosecute internal & external voting frauds as felonies

3. System Operations

- Implement chain-of-custody and audit records
- Conduct background checks on all with access to voting system elements
- Computer security provisions to meet federal system security criteria of banking and federal info security levels



Election Integrity Action Committee Prime Objective: ***Audits Of Nevada Elections By Independent CFEs***

- **All 3 Parts** of State & Federal Elections To Be **Independently Audited** At County Levels **Before, During and After** Each Election
- Ballots To Be Managed With Procedures Equal Or Better Than Money
- Candidates Suspecting Errors Or Fraud To Be Allowed To Inspect Ballots in **3 Selected Precincts of Their Choice**--Without Candidate Expense
- **District Attorneys** To Be Authorized To Open Sealed County Election Records **At Any Time Without Court Approval** To Investigate Possible Malfunctions and/or Fraud
